### Coronavirus Update

We have now received further guidance clarifying the 14 day household self-isolation for families:

- If your child develops a continuous cough and/or high temperature then isolate your household for 14 days. However, your child may return to school after 7 days of first exhibiting the symptoms if he/she feels better and does not have a high temperature.
- If you develop a continuous cough and/or high temperature then isolate your household for 14 days (includes your children). You may return to your normal activity after 7 days of first exhibiting the symptoms if you feel better and do not have a high temperature. However, your children and other family members must stay isolated until the 14 days are over. After the 14 days, they can then return to normal routine as long as they feel better and do not have a high temperature.
- If a member of your household develops a continuous cough and/or high temperature during the 14 day isolation period, their 7 days isolation commences.

Eg. A family member develops a cough and/or high temperature on day 2 of the 14 day household isolation, after 7 days that family member can return to normal routines as long as they feel better and do not have a high temperature.

As a school we are monitoring the situation on a daily basis and taking advice from Gov.uk, the DfE and Local Authority.
