

Responses from Parent Survey



May 2023

In March 2023, at Parents' Evening, we handed out a Parent Survey. We received **312 responses**, which represents 56% of the school population. The leadership of the school values the survey to gauge what it is doing well and to also listen to the needs of Parents/Carers and consider what could be done differently.

As always, Parents are encouraged to meet with their child's class teacher to discuss their child's learning or share any concerns.

Survey Results:

Key findings:

We are delighted that 98% of parents and carers are highly satisfied with the level of communication school offers; including curriculum newsletters, individual progress reports and opportunities for meetings with teachers throughout the school year. The Parentapps Connect App has also been well received, providing an efficient paperless system for notifications and information.

99% of parents responded positively with regard to their child's progress and the high standard of their work at school, together with 98% of children finding lessons interesting.

A small percentage of parents would like us to offer further after-school sports clubs. Our current (free) provision extends to all children in Y1-6 throughout the week, with multiple clubs on some evenings. Due to limited availability of indoor space, we are currently unable to extend our sports offer, but are looking into other types of after-school clubs.

Thank you for taking the time to complete the questionnaire; it is important to us that we are the best we can be and your comments and support are crucial to us in providing our children with the best education possible.
